Money Matters—from the Treasurer

For the calendar year 2023, our income from contributions was \$193,000. Our expenses were \$242,000. That leaves us with a \$49,000 deficit for the year. Through investments, we gained approximately \$10,000 in interest during 2023. By applying our 2023 interest gains to our contributions, we can reduce the negative impact of underfunding our budget to approximately -\$39,000 for 2023. We continue to monitor our gains from investments. Current investments total \$664,000.
