Money Matters – From the Treasurer

In January, 2024, our income from contributions was **\$18,367** and our expenses totaled **\$25,522.** In January, we spent **\$7,155** more than we received in contributions. **This means we are starting 2024 with a deficit.**

We continue to monitor our gains from investments. Current investments total \$664,000. However, unless we as a church (both members and visitors) do something differently, i.e., increase contributions, decrease expenditures, or both, we will continue to experience monthly deficits.
