## **Money Matters – From the Treasurer**

In February, 2024, our income from contributions was **\$16,482** and our expenses totaled **\$45,121.** In February, we spent **\$10,272** more than we received in contributions. This means we are continuing with monthly deficits.

## NOTE: CMUMC paid several "annual" fees/expenses in January that should not recur during 2024.

We continue to monitor our gains from investments. Current investments total \$700,000. However, unless we as a church (both members and visitors) do something differently, i.e., increase contributions, decrease expenditures, or both, we will continue to experience monthly deficits.
